Before you claim you'll need:

- the donor's UK bank account number and sort code
- a copy of the LPA (if you have it)

### Claim by phone

You must claim by phone if:

- the donor doesn't have a UK bank account.
- you're a court-appointed deputy
- you have a trust organisation as the attorney
